The mansion was built by Tommy Smith in 1889 and was the family home until 1944 when it became a seminary. Now the property is privately owned and offers accommodation, tours and dining experiences as well as a beautiful location to hold a wedding!

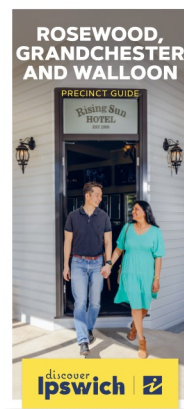
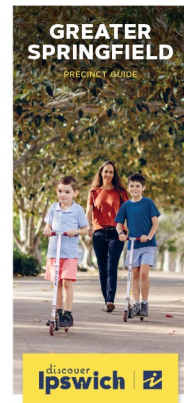

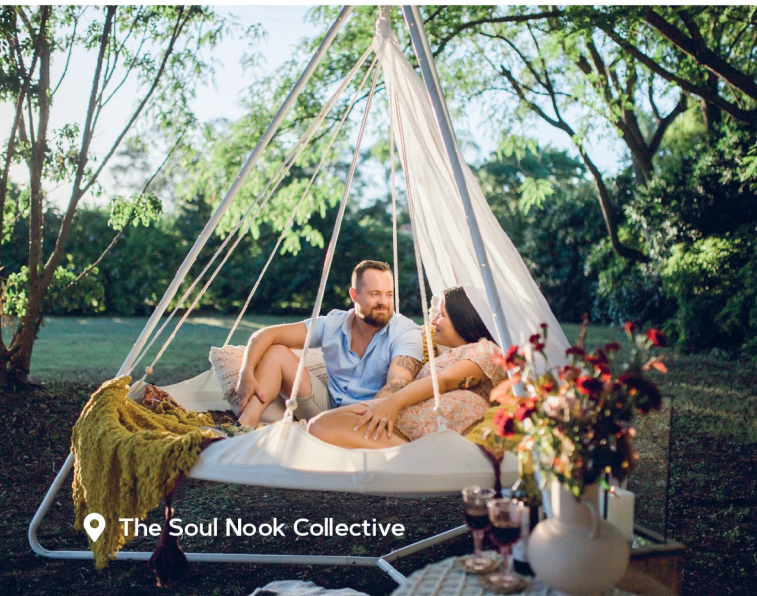
