Woodlands of Marburg is a sprawling mansion estate set on 300 acres in the hills of Marburg.

The mansion was built by Tommy Smith in 1889 and was the family home until 1944 when it became a seminary. Now the property is privately owned and offers accommodation, tours and dining experiences as well as a beautiful location to hold a wedding!

Head out on weekends for all day breakfast, brunch or a coffee at the Tommy Smith Cafe onsite. Or book a table on Friday and Saturday nights to dine inside the mansion in the Sugarmill Restaurant. This fine dining restaurant will transport you to a time of elegance and splendour under glistening chandeliers.
